Pedigree enthusiast Dan Bearden, who entered the Thoroughbred industry about eight years ago with a \$5,000 claimer, was represented by his first big winner when homebred San Pablo rallied to a 3 1/2-length victory in the Aug. 18 Philip H. Iselin Stakes (gr. III) at Monmouth Park.

The 4-year-old son of Jump Start, who won his stakes debut in the Flying Chevron Stakes last year at Aqueduct, notched additional black-type scores in the Jan. 14 Shots Are Ringing Stakes at Aqueduct as well as the Aug. 2 Birdstone Stakes at Saratoga. He has now earned \$382,800 from 12 starts.

Bearden, who owns a trucking company in Arkansas, has six horses in training under the name of his Burning Sands Stable. He also keeps several mares in Arkansas, New York, and Kentucky, including San Pablo's dam, Hunt's Corner.

"I was absolutely fascinated with the breeding end of (the industry)," said Bearden, who acquired his first Blood-Horse Stallion Register in 2005. "I read that from the front to the back—until the pages were falling out of it."

Bearden acquired Hunt's Corner in 2005 from a breeding and racing partnership with which he was formerly involved. "I wanted to exit out of the syndicate, so I made an offer (on the mare). The guys in the syndicate now say I took the training wheels off the syndicate," he said with a laugh.

By Silver Ghost, Hunt's Corner was a winner and earner of nearly \$40,000 on the racetrack. She has gone on to produce 10 named foals, seven of which are winners, including San Pablo's half brother Slider (by Prenup), a restricted stakes winner who was twice graded stakes-placed. The son of Prenup retired with earnings of more than \$600,000.

San Pablo was foaled at Dana and Gerry Aschinger's War Horse Place near Lexington. His 22-year-old dam produced a colt by Arkansas stallion Portobello Road April 5 and is in foal to Posse for 2013.

Jump Start is the sire of 28 stakes winners. Among his six added-money winners of 2012 are other graded victors Rail Trip (gr. II) and Outta Tune (gr. III). Jump Start, a grade II-winning son of A.P. Indy, stood for \$10,000 in 2012 at Northview PA near Peach Bottom, Pa.—E.M.

Winding Way's first victory in an added-money event was a dramatic one. The 3-year-old filly broke last as the favorite and then rallied widest of all in the stretch to take the Aug. 19 Rancho Bernardo Handicap (gr. III) at Del Mar by a half-length over Sugarinthemorning.

Ridden by Rafael Bejarano, Winding Way was the youngest runner in the field of seven fillies and mares. The 3-year-old dark bay or brown filly carried 114 pounds, Top-weighted Home Sweet Aspen, who toted 120 pounds, finished last. Winding Way covered 6 1/2 furlongs in 1:15.93 while remaining undefeated in three races.
